Ministry of Health priorities

The Ministry of Health is pushing to create a truly integrated system of health care that works for patients and not just for us. The three new priorities closely align with the work we have underway at VCH:

- 2. Timely access to surgical care
- 3. Effective and sustainable rural health service

Clinical and Systems Transformation (CST)

The CST project remains a top priority for VCH, the Provincial Health Services Authority and Providence Health Care. It's in our patients' best interest to have a single electronic health record and standardized clinical practices—and that requires a single instance of the Cerner system across our organizations.

Deciding to part ways with Team IBM was the right thing to do. We are committed to learning from our experience so far and implementing the project on a timeline that gives us the clinical outcomes we need. A transition plan is in the works to ensure a smooth knowledge transfer from IBM to the health organizations.
