Quick Facts

- **May 13 to 15:** The construction crane will be installed.
- **Crane height:** Up to 55 metres — that's almost 17 storeys high.
- **Crane onsite:** Approximately 10 months.
- **Crane operating hours:** Monday to Friday — 7 am to 4 pm.

Questions & Answers

Q Will installing the crane affect traffic and lane access at VGH?

A The Willow Street lane will remain closed to vehicles while the crane is installed May 13 through May 15. Pedestrians and cyclists can continue to use Willow lane to cross the inner courtyard at VGH.

Q Will the crane affect air ambulance access to the helipad?

A No – the helipad will remain open and the flight path for the helicopter air ambulance won't change. Nav Canada is informed and all required permits have been acquired to ensure safety. Beacon lights will be installed on the crane for night flights.

Q How high will the crane be in relation to buildings on campus?

A The crane will be taller than all nearby buildings, including the Centennial, Research and Blusson Pavilions. At about 55 metres in height, the crane will stand 8 to 9 metres taller than Centennial Pavilion.

Q How many floors will the Joseph & Rosalie Segal Family Health Centre (JRSFHC) be?

A The JRSFHC will be an eight-storey mental health and addictions facility, providing 100 inpatient beds and a range of outpatient programs and services. The building's design and planned amenities — including a rooftop garden — were developed in consultation with patients, clients, physicians and staff.

Q When will the JRSFHC open?

A We're on schedule to open the JRSFHC mid-2017.
